Policy and Procedures Guidance Bulletin #14

Topic: state share for AWOS projects August 26, 2013

Issue: AWOS systems contribute to the safety of the state's aviation network, and they need to be kept operating to continue supporting safe operations.

Guidance: On August 23, 2013, the Virginia Aviation Board adopted a policy change that increases the state's funding portion of AWOS installations, upgrades, and maintenance for sponsor-owned systems from 80 percent to 95 percent. The funding participation for other F&E systems and equipment owned by DOAV or a sponsor does not change. The policy of not participating in maintenance for federally-owned AWOS systems is to be continued.
